Scott Reiner '82 has dedicated his life to serving others through his leadership skills. After graduating from MBA, Scott went on to Pacific Union College where he earned a bachelor's degree in Nursing. Later, he earned a master's degree in Health Administration from California State University, Northridge and a Certificate in Managed Care Administration from the University of Missouri. His dedication to healthcare led him to his position as CEO of Adventist Health.

A registered nurse with 25 years of healthcare leadership, Scott has a true passion for mission, especially serving the underserved. He is committed to quality care, experience, and expanding the sense of mission into the community. As the CEO, Scott is responsible for setting the vision and direction of Adventist Health, a faith-based, nonprofit integrated health system, founded on Seventh-day Adventist heritage and values, that serves more than 75 communities in California, Hawaii, Oregon, and Washington.

Prior to joining Adventist Health, Scott served as the Senior Vice President of Strategic Operations at General Health System in Baton Rouge, Louisiana. He also served as Vice President of Specialty Operations and Vice President for Development and Managed Care at Tennessee Christian Medical Center in Nashville, TN.

In 1999, Scott began his leadership with Adventist Health as the CEO of Glendale Adventist Medical Center. After seven years of service at Glendale, Scott assumed the role of senior vice president of Adventist Health in 2006. This kept him busy chairing the boards of nine hospitals and overseeing business development, innovations, and philanthropy from the corporate office. In 2010, Scott's talents and skills were rewarded when he was named executive senior vice president and COO, making him responsible for the day-to-day operations of Adventist Health. This role included visioning, building, implementing, and obtaining leaders needed to carry out the strategy and goals of the organization.

In September of 2013, when Robert Carmen announced he would retire from his position of CEO of Adventist Health, the board of directors looked for a leader who would continue to promote Adventist Health's distinctive mission and purpose and to guide its strategic planning and decision making processes. According to then board chairman, Ricardo Graham,

In December of 2013, Scott was appointed President and CEO of Adventist Health.
